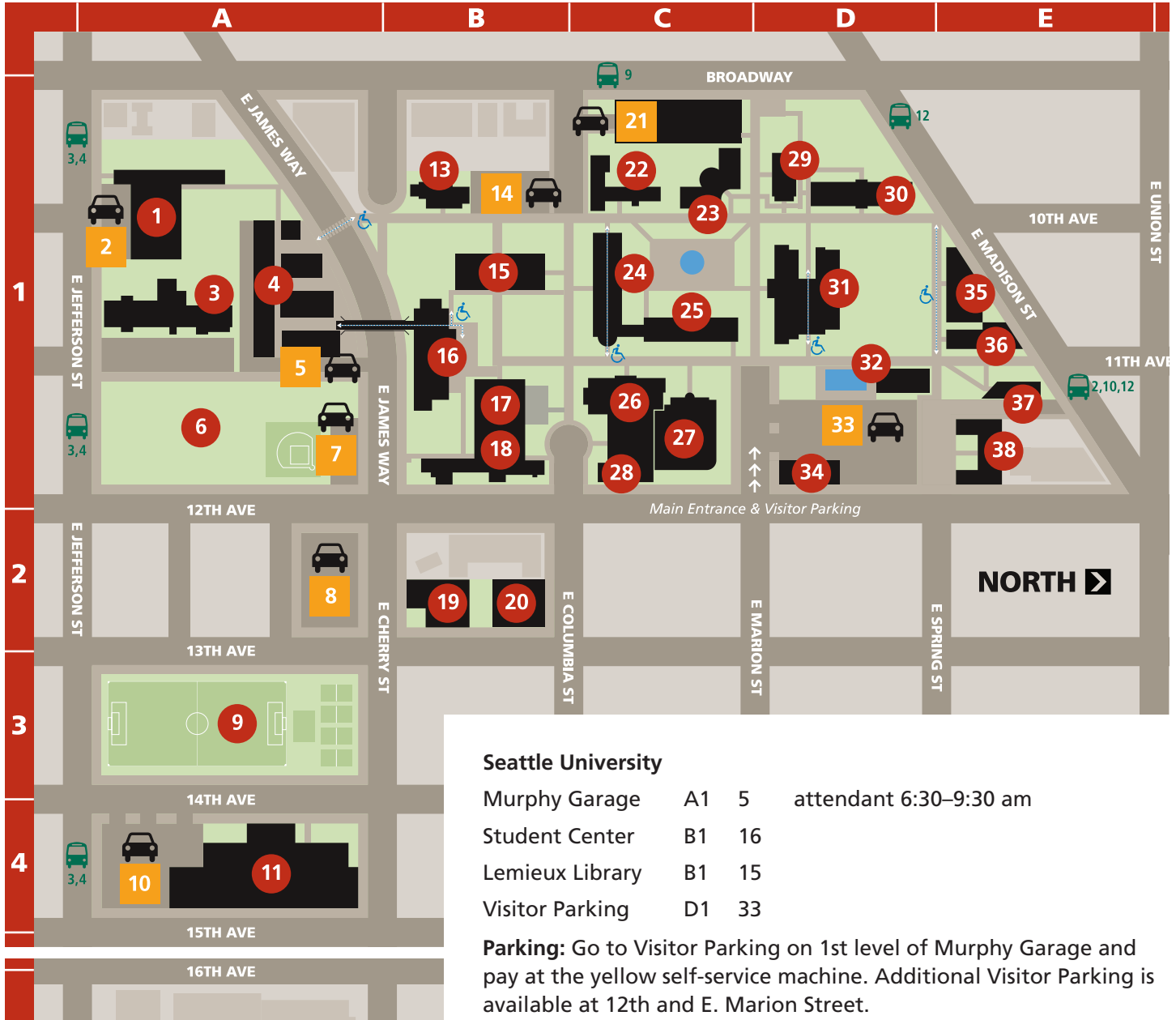

Directions from Murphy Garage to the Student Center

From the south

1. Head north on I-5
2. Take exit 164A to James Street
3. Right onto James Street
4. Right into Murphy Garage

From the east on I-90

1. Head west on I-90 toward Seattle
2. Take exit 2C toward I-5 North
3. Take the James Street exit
4. Right onto James Street
5. Right into Murphy Garage

From the east on WA-520

1. Head west on WA-520
2. Merge onto I-5 South toward Portland
3. Take exit 165A to James Street
4. Left onto James Street
5. Right into Murphy Garage
